<b><u>DECOUPAGE ON TIN TECHNIQUE</u></b> Decoupage technique on tin, using serviettes or paper cut outs, and sponging method.	R165	<b><u>ANTIQUÉ CRACKLE &amp; QUICK CRACK</u></b> Decoupage technique with crackle methods on teaspoon tray and light switch cover or similar surface	R170
<b><u>HIGH GLOSS RESIN FINISH ON WOOD TECHNIQUE</u></b> Decoupage technique with a two part resin waterproof finish on a teaspoon tray or bevelled coasters.	R185	<b><u>SERVIETTE MINI TRIO</u></b> Learn to decoupage serviettes on three surfaces such as stone, fabric, wood, plastic, terracotta using appropriate mediums	R175
<b><u>CLOCK PROJECT</u></b> Decoupage technique to create wall clock or CD clock on stand with numerals & mechanism included	R185	<b><u>ON GLASS DECOUPAGE TECHNIQUE</u></b> Mulberry paper & serviettes with beading on an ordinary vase shaped glass to create a candle light	R170
<b><u>ENAMEL DECOUPAGE</u></b> Decoupage technique to decorate an enamel bowl/plate using paper/serviettes paints and varnishes.	R185	<b><u>PAINT TECHNIQUES</u></b> Learn four paint techniques on sample boards with notes, faux wood, distressing, faux rust etc for enhancing decoupage products and décor items.	R190
<b><u>UNDER GLASS DECOUPAGE TECHNIQUE</u></b> Covers cutting, painting and sealing under glass to create a fully washable item. Make a small 20 cm plate/bowl.	R185	<b><u>OSTRICH SHELL MOSAIC</u></b> Using ostrich shell pieces and embellishments in place of mosaic tiles decorate a frame, box or pencil tidy	R180
<b><u>MOSAICS</u></b> Mosaic a wooden frame/ planter pot/ house number/cross/heart, butterfly etc – learn to nip tiles, basic design arrangements, glue and grout	R200	<b><u>WOOD CRAFT PAINTING</u></b> Learn how to transform dull pieces of supawood into a character from a fairy, angels, teddies, Christmas characters, garden signs	R145 - R170
